- **Nicaragua branch of Visions Guatemala** – registered (June 2019)
- **Visions Global Empowerment India** – nonprofit incorporated in 2016; on track to receive federal FCRA status in late 2019

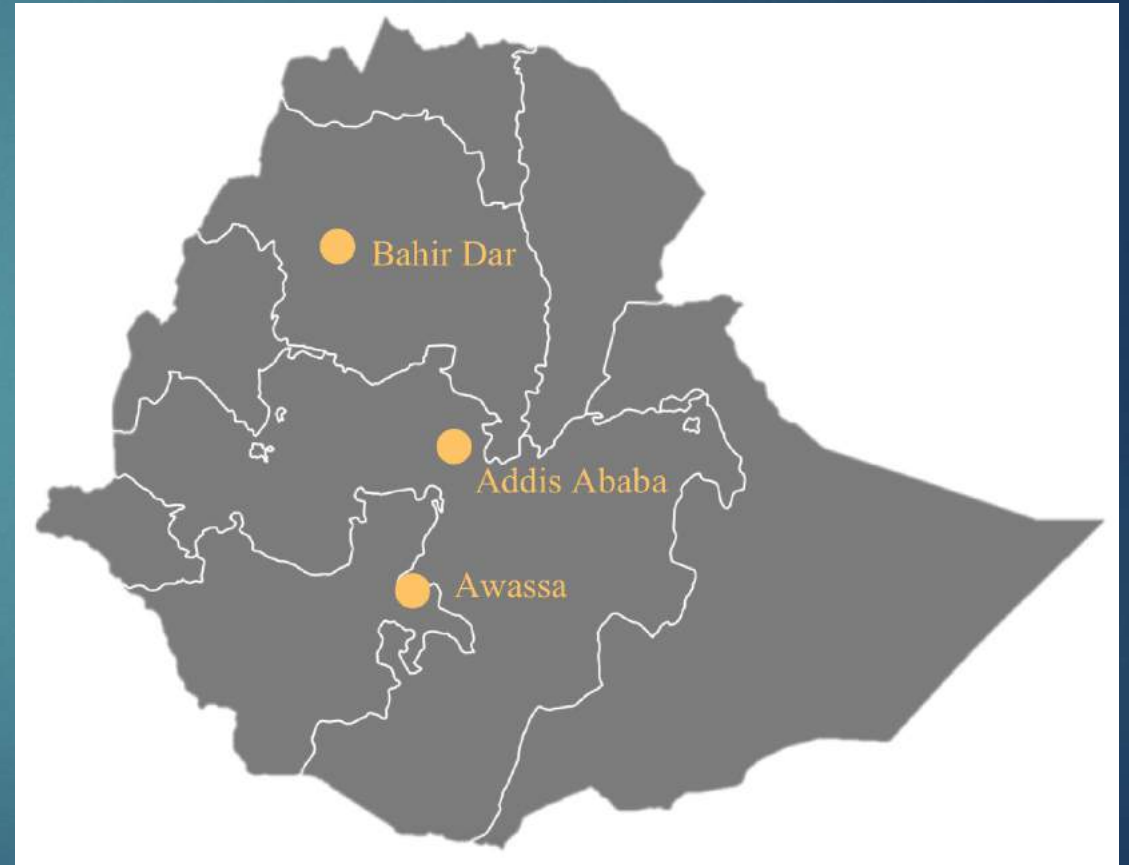

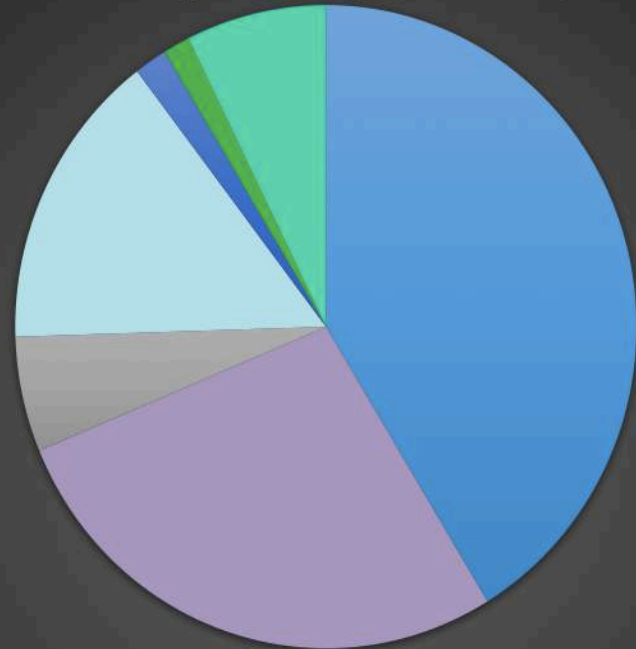

2016 SPENDING (BY CATEGORY)

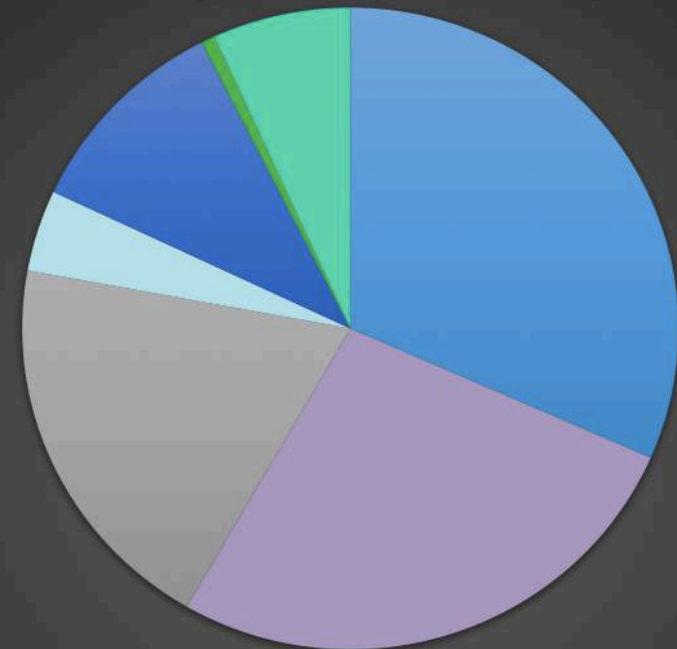

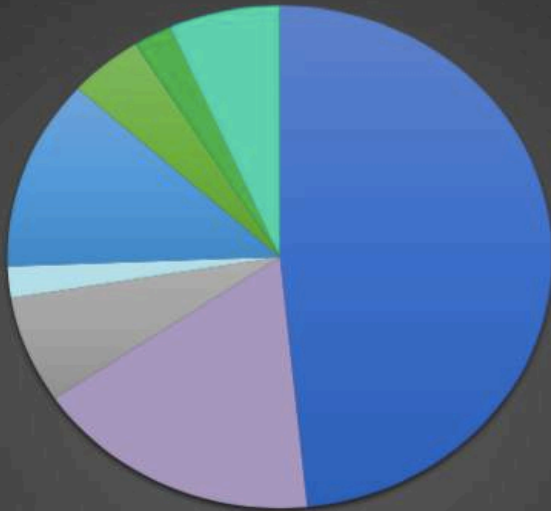

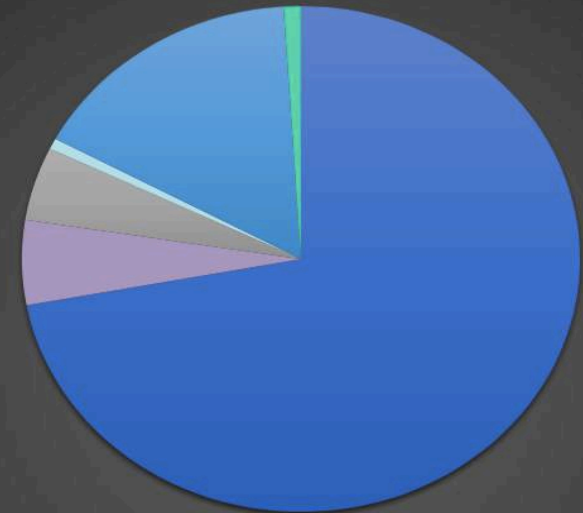
